FROM FATHER PAUL

Does the name Carlo Acutis mean anything to you? If not you will probably hear a lot about him in coming months. Carlo was beatified on 10 October in Assisi and the symbols associated with him – a laptop, a rosary and the Blessed Sacrament – underline the reality that, in all probability, he will be the first millennial to be declared a saint.

The most remarkable fact about Blessed Carlo is his age – he was fifteen when he died. To have matured so early in the things of God is a true miracle of grace made all the more interesting for us in Marylebone as we can claim him as a sort of neighbour. Carlo Acutis was born in London, before his parents set up home in Milan where he was to spend the rest of his short life. The Acutis family was nominally Catholic but not practicing: his Mother says that she went to Mass only for her First Holy Communion, Confirmation and her wedding but from a very young age Carlo seemed to have had a special capacity for friendship with God which took on a new depth once he began to receive the Eucharist. He became a daily Communicant, often spending a Holy Hour of adoration before or after Mass; he went to confession each week and he could write “the more often we receive the Eucharist, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of heaven”.

A witness records that Carlo: “managed to drag his parents to Mass every day. It was not the other way round: it was he who managed to get himself to Mass and to convince others to receive communion daily”. Precocious yes, in the things of the spirit, but in others ways a thoroughly ordinary representative of his own generation. Carlo loved video games and was adept at Super Mario and Pokémon – this facility with his laptop led him to teach himself how to program and he set up websites cataloguing the world’s Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions,, to which he was adding up until his death. At the beatification ceremony it was said about him: “*he was an ordinary boy, simple, spontaneous, likeable – he loved nature and animals, he played football, he had many friends of his own age, he was attracted by modern means of communication to transmit the Gospel, to communicate values and beauty*”.


As he entered his teenage years, Carol Acutis was given the diagnosis of the leukemia which was to end his earthly life. His adolescence cannot have been easy with the attempts at treatment and increasing weakness and discomfort. He offered his sufferings for Pope Benedict XVI and for the Church saying: “*I offer all the suffering I have to*

endure for the Lord, for the Pope and the Church". When asked by a doctor about the level of his pain, he responded: "there are people who suffer much more than me".


He died on October 12th, 2006 and out of his devotion to Saint Francis he asked to be buried in Assisi, For the beatification ceremony there last Sunday, Carlo's body was displayed in a glass casket dressed in the jeans and a pair of Nikes, the casual clothes he preferred in life. If he had still been alive, he would only be twenty-nine.

What does Blessed Carlo Acutis have to say to us? Firstly, the Church encourages us to ask for his intercession. At every stage on the way to canonization there have to be significant signs that a saint is in heaven and in Therese of Lisieux's phrase "doing good works on earth". We should be confident in asking Carlo's prayer, but it is the examples he sets which underlines his importance for us today. We expect sanctity to be a gift of the Spirit which attaches to age – we assume there must be a certain maturity of experience if we are truly to have "the mind of Christ".

Blessed Carlo blows those expectancies out of the water. He demonstrates that a teenager can have as intimate an understanding of God's heart as anyone, and he stands as a challenge to all our young people to take the Gospel seriously – and to want to become saints in their turn. "Those who trust in him will understand the truth, those who are faithful will live with him in love; for grace and mercy await those he has chosen" (Wisdom 3:9).
