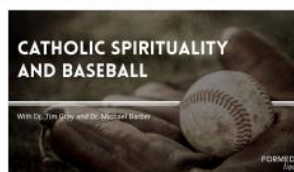
JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT

FORMED NOW! CATHOLIC SPIRITUALITY AND BASEBALL

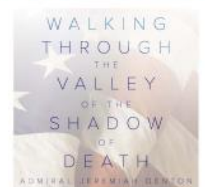
