### ALLELUIA!

The Entrance Antiphon and Collect of Today's Mass speak of the new life of the baptised. Today's Gospel tells of the appearances of Our Lord to the Apostles both on the day of His resurrection, and exactly one week later, that is, today.

On this second occasion He shows His glorified wounds, just as they are represented in the Paschal Candle, and Thomas recognises His "Lord and God".

During Eastertide, there are several changes to the Liturgy of the Word. In the first place, the First reading is not taken from the Old Testament as is usual. Instead, we hear a Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, which tells us of the preaching of the Apostles under the power of the Holy Spirit. Secondly, we hear the word, "alleluia", sung or uttered more often. This reflects the love of the Church for the sound of the word "Alleluia", of which we had been deprived throughout the austerities of Lent.

### RECENT FEDERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

On February 21<sup>st</sup>, Cardinal Leo sent a letter to the Honourable Dominic Le Blanc, The Minister of Finance, to express his profound concerns about the recent Finance Committee's pre-budget report.

In this letter he speaks to recommendation 429 to: "No longer provide charitable status to anti-abortion organizations." And recommendation 430 to: "Amend the Income Tax Act to provide a definition of a charity which would remove the privileged status of 'advancement of religion' as a charitable purpose."

Among the points Cardinal Leo makes is that there are countless groups and associations in our country that enjoy charitable status with views that differ from large segments of the population for any number of reasons. And that a government truly at the service of the population must necessarily consider that our Canadian society, is made up of innumerable persons and communities who are religious and for whom religion places a most important role in their life and activities.
