Red Wednesday – November 19

The scale of Christian persecution today is staggering and calls for our urgent attention and fervent prayer. According to the most recent report from Aid to the Church in Need, grave violations of religious freedom occurred in 62 countries affecting nearly 5.4 billion people, or 64.7% of the world's population. These sobering realities underscore the threat to the faith in hostile environments, yet they also inspire us to hope, for as pilgrims of hope, we know that Christ's resurrection triumphs over every form of darkness and injustice.

On Wednesday, November 19, people around the world will mark Red Wednesday, an initiative of Aid to the Church in Need (ACN). This global day highlights the persecution of Christians and reminds us that religious freedom is a human right. In Toronto, the Archdiocese of Toronto invites the Catholic community to participate in Mass at 5:30 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, where Bishop John Boissonneau, Auxiliary Bishop of Toronto will preside.
